

COVID -19 Checklists for dance lessons

Below is a list of new measures that I will put into place when running my Adult dance session at Knappe Cross Community Centre due to the on-going COVID 19 restrictions and Government advice.

Social distancing

My sessions will observe social distancing measures at all times. Class numbers will be limited and booking will need to be done online.

There will be a one way system through the building which will be clearly marked and labelled so all customers follow a set route. Members will enter through the front door and exit via the fire exit at the back of the hall.

I will provide hand sanitizer and ensure all members using the hall use the hand sanitizer when entering.

I will have a written record of contact details for every person that has used the hall during my dance session for track and trace purposes should anyone report symptoms.

Cleaning

All doors and windows must be kept open when using the hall. This includes the front door and fire exit which must be wedged open at all times.

All light switches must be wiped down upon opening and exiting the halls plus any other key contact surfaces.

The only toilet in use is the disabled toilet which must be cleaned after each use. I will strongly recommend members use their own facilities and come changed and ready to dance reducing contact with hall facilities.

The kitchen will be out of use.

All those taking part in a dance session have read and agree to follow the above guidelines and do so at their own risk.
